**PETITION OF RETAIL ENERGY SUPPLY ASSOCIATION
FOR INTERVENOR STATUS**

The Retail Energy Supply Association (“RESA”)¹ hereby petitions the Connecticut Department of Public Utility Control (“Department”) to be designated as an intervenor in the above-captioned proceeding pursuant to Section 4-177a(b) of the General Statutes and Section 16-1-18 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies. In support of this petition, RESA states as follows:

1. RESA is a nonprofit corporation and a trade association that represents the interests of member retail electricity suppliers in regulatory proceedings.
2. On January 17, 2007, Constellation NewEnergy, Inc. (“Constellation”) filed a letter with the Department requesting that it authorize the electric distribution companies (“EDCs”) to give customer ICAP tag information to retail electricity suppliers upon request. The Department is treating Constellation’s January 17, 2007 letter as a request for a declaratory ruling as to whether release of the ICAP tag information is permitted by Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-245o, which governs restrictions on the use of customer information for marketing purposes and associated topics.

3. RESA members, like Constellation, require the ICAP tag information in order to properly administer the capacity charges they incur on behalf of their respective customers. Accordingly, the interests of RESA members will be specifically affected by the Department's ruling in this proceeding.

4. RESA requests the right to submit pre-filed testimony and written comments, to present witnesses and submit legal briefs, to propound interrogatories and to cross-examine witnesses, and to otherwise participate fully in any hearings to be held in this proceeding.

5. RESA's participation in this proceeding will assist the Department by providing information and insight from additional retail electricity suppliers. RESA's participation will not impede the Department's expeditious completion of this proceeding.


