for Waiver of Standard Service and Last Resort Service Stays

Dear Ms. Rickard:

On May 29, 2007, the Retail Energy Supply Association (“RESA”) filed a petition with the Department of Public Utility Control (“Department”) for a declaratory ruling that Section 16-244c(e) of the General Statutes and the Department’s June 21, 2006 Decision in Docket No. 06-01-08PH01 (“June 2006 Decision”) allow the Department to waive the mandatory stays on last resort service (“LRS”) and standard service, respectively, under the limited circumstances described in the petition. RESA wishes to withdraw its petition because subsequent acts of the Legislature and the Department have rendered the petition moot.

After RESA submitted its petition, Public Act No. 07-242, *An Act Concerning Electricity and Energy Efficiency* (“Act”), was signed into law. Section 49 of the Act eliminates the mandatory stay on LRS that was previously embodied in Section 16-244c(e). Likewise, on October 10, 2007, the Department issued a Decision in Docket No. 05-08-05RE02, which eliminated the mandatory stay on standard service that was adopted by the Department in its June 2006 Decision. As a result of these actions, it is no longer necessary for the Department to review RESA’s petition.
