1. On May 9, 2012, the Authority, on its own motion, opened this proceeding to identify and review the various charges on electric bills and the costs passed through each charge. *See* Request to Establish a New Docket on PURA’s Own Motion, dated May 9, 2012; *see also* Notice of Request for Written Comments, dated June 14, 2012 (“Notice”).
2. On June 14, 2012, the Authority issued the Notice offering interested persons an opportunity to submit written comments on specified topics, including any comments that would assist the Authority in its investigation and review. *See* Notice at 1.
3. RESA is a non-profit organization and trade association that represents the interests of its members in regulatory proceedings in the Mid-Atlantic, Great Lakes, New York
