The Connecticut competitive retail electricity market continues to deliver a wide range of valuable energy options for consumers. The information below is based on a review of currently available offers from electricity supplies as published on the state’s official Generation Supply Rate Board ([www.energizect.com](http://www.energizect.com)).

**New & Notable**

- **There are 100% renewable energy options available for less than the applicable standard service rate.**
  - For Eversource customers, the lowest green option is 7.09 cents per kWh for a 100% renewable fixed rate for 6 billing cycles, 11% less than the Eversource standard service rate
  - For United Illuminating customers, the lowest green option is 7.09 cents per kWh for a 100% renewable fixed rate for 6 billing cycles, less than the United Illuminating standard service rate
- **Long-term price certainty. There are five offers available for a three-year fixed rate.**
