**RETAIL ENERGY SUPPLY ASSOCIATION'S  
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

The Retail Energy Supply Association (“RESA”)<sup>1</sup> hereby moves the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority (the “Authority”) for an extension of time until **January 6, 2022** to respond to the Office of Education, Outreach, and Enforcement (“EOE”) and the Office of Consumer Counsel’s (“OCC’s”) December 20, 2021 Motion to Stay Proceeding and Petition to Open a New Docket (“Motion No. 2”).<sup>2</sup> In support of this motion, RESA offers the following:

1. On December 10, 2021, the Authority reopened Docket No. 18-06-02,<sup>3</sup> pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes sections 16-245o(m) and 16-262c, to reevaluate Order 2 in its December 18, 2019 Decision,<sup>4</sup> which required the electric distribution companies to return all hardship customers to Standard Service and prevent future hardship customers from contracting with electric suppliers.<sup>5</sup>
2. On December 20, 2021, EOE and OCC filed Motion No. 2, which requests that the Authority open a new docket to allow for investigation of supplier offers pursuant to

Connecticut General Statutes section 16-245(a) and to stay the instant proceeding pending resolution of such new docket.<sup>6</sup>

3. RESA intends to respond to Motion No. 2. Given the upcoming holidays and other business commitments, to ensure that it has sufficient time to prepare a response, RESA requests that it, as well as any other participant, be permitted to respond by **January 6, 2022**.

**WHEREFORE**, the Authority should allow RESA, as well as any other participant, to respond to Motion No. 2 by **January 6, 2022**.


